



Greensboro's Art Takes Center Stage

ArtStock Studio Tour is Set for Oct. 21-22, 2023

ArtStock Studio Tour 2023 is set to launch another year of showcasing local artisans' creations. A revitalization of the event, which is marking its 25th year, will include more than 45 artists and begin with an Open Party at Revolution Mill's Gallery 1250 on Oct. 19 from 6 to 9 p.m. That evening visitors will view pieces from each participating artist and see a live demonstration of art in the making.

The real fun begins on Saturday, Oct. 21 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. when the artists open their studios to the public and again on Sunday from 1 to 5 p.m. Many artists will feature their work in select locations including Artmongerz, Sternberger Art Center, Studio 503, and Greensboro Cultural Arts Center. Others will open their personal studios to the public. A detailed map will guide visitors to the studios, and volunteers will be stationed at the galleries to greet people and answer questions.

"We're encouraging people to start their tour at Revolution Mill's 1250 Gallery to see the art and decide which studios they wish to visit. Many of our artists will open their personal studios for the weekend so folks can see how the creativity takes place," said Terry Wessling, ArtStock's coordinator and a participating artist.

This year's ArtStock Studio Tour features visual art from jewelry to pottery to fiber and fabric to collages to digital imagery to traditional and abstract paintings and printmaking. Art on display that weekend is available for purchase from the galleries, personal studios, and through the ArtStock Studio Tour online gallery.

Artstock Studio Tour is free, the 1250 Gallery at Revolution Mill and each location will have red balloons and signage stationed outside for easy identification.
